### OVERVIEW

This IMI Level 2 NVQ is aimed at technicians working on routine removal and replacement tasks automotive glazing industry. It covers the key skills required by technicians who remove and replace glazing components on all types of motor vehicle.

This qualification was developed with input from employers and training providers; and therefore includes the core knowledge and skills required by the sector.

Learners taking this qualification must be 16 years or over and be working in an Automotive Glazing environment. There are no other formal entry requirements for this qualification and learners are not expected to have any prior knowledge or experience. However GCSEs in Maths and English at grades D-F are recommended. Selection for entry should take into account each applicant's existing academic/vocational qualifications, experience and interest in working in the sector.

### WHO IS THE QUALIFICATION FOR?

This VRQ is suitable for:

- automotive glazing technicians with more than two years' experience – and who have not previously gained a national qualification.
- new industry recruits – this Diploma provides the mandatory competence (NVQ) component for the Apprenticeship in Automotive Glazing

### WHAT DOES THIS QUALIFICATION COVER?

Learners will develop their skills and knowledge in the following Automotive Glazing topic areas:

- Health and Safety in an automotive Glass Related Environment
- Automotive Glazing and Related Vehicle Products (knowledge only)
- Preparing to Carry Out Automotive Glazing Work
- Handing Over Vehicles to Automotive Glazing Customers
- Removing and Installing Fixed Automotive Glass in Vehicles
- Removing and Installing Opening Automotive Glass in Vehicles



Learners will also have a selection of optional units to develop their skills and knowledge in the following Automotive Glazing topic areas:

- Shaping Automotive Glass for Installation in Vehicles
- Working with Others Within the Automotive Glazing Environment
- Shaping Non-Glass Based Automotive Glazing Materials
- Repairing Damaged Laminated Glass in Vehicles

### **ASSESSMENT**

Learners will demonstrate their skills and knowledge by collecting evidence of their work and being observed in their workplace. This evidence is usually presented in a portfolio (however your approved centre may use an alternative method). The assessor will advise learners how to generate, collect and present their evidence.

### **PROGRESSION**

For some learners this qualification could prepare them for progression to further learning and training. For others, this qualification could also provide a useful recognition of their practical skills and knowledge, to aid their step from one job role to another.
