



ACCREDITATION

There is a change being made to IMI Accreditation products; we are replacing the Code of Conduct with Professional Standards. This means achievers of an Accreditation will now have to agree to work to a Professional Standard of behaviours instead of the Code of Conduct.

We attach a 'standardised' PDF presentation that we ask you to use for Accreditation inductions with individuals who are taking part in your Accreditation programmes. This will help you deliver the right messages about the IMI, the Professional Standards and also ensure that both organisations meet the requirements of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) that came into force on the 25th May 2018. The latter is in respect of the fact that individuals achieving an Accreditation automatically become an IMI member and will be placed on the IMI publicly facing Professional Register, which they must be informed about.
